

The keynote speaker on the occasion was Dr. Pankaj Mala Sharma, former Chairperson Department of Music Punjab University Chandigarh.

After the ceremonial lighting of the lamp the Principal GLDM GDC Hiranagar Dr. Pragya Khanna presented formal welcome address. The Principal held that Music is the very essence of life and the new age of interdisciplinary studies has made it pertinent to explore the convergence and probabilities amongst different disciplines.
